



Big Game Fishing in New Zealand

Day 1

Arrival to Auckland International Airport, you are met by your guide and transferred privately to your Auckland hotel for rest and relaxation after the flight.

Enjoy a city tour of Auckland in the afternoon – the biggest and busiest Pacific metropolis, melting pot of many cultures and nations and a very vibrant and pleasant city situated between two ocean harbours.



Day 2

Transfer to the Bay of Islands, charming resort area to the North of Auckland and big game fishing capital of New Zealand.

In the afternoon – tour of Waitangi grounds – the birthplace of New Zealand nation, where Maori chiefs signed the Treaty of Waitangi in 1840 with the British Crown.

Day 3

Early in the morning meet with your skipper and start your New Zealand big game fishing experience. Fast ocean motor boat will take you to the best places in the archipelago to fish for marlin, tuna, snapper, mako, hapuka and others. Enjoy lunch on one of the uninhabited islands in the Bay, prepared by crew member.



Day 4

Another day of fishing, swimming and relaxing in the Bay of Islands. Helicopter will transfer you to one of the remote islands in the Bay and you will try surf casting fishing – traditional New Zealand fishing from the shore.



Day 5

Today your Maori fishing expert will introduce you to traditional Maori fishing experience – eeling. Enjoy the whole day of wonderful cultural experience and relax in hot water mineral springs on the way back.



Day 6

Today you take a rest from fishing and will be transferred by helicopter to the iconic 90mile beach in the north of North Island for a quad bike adventure on the beach. Enjoy the adrenaline rush from racing on giant sand dunes. In the afternoon – land in a boutique vineyard that Bay of Islands is famous for and savor an excellent meal accompanied by locally made outstanding wines.

Today you are returning to Auckland and your New Zealand fishing trip ends only to start dreaming about a new one immediately.
