Auckland City Tour

Your tour will start from your hotel or from the cruise ship terminal (if you are getting off the cruise liner in Auckland). You will see the best of the "City of Sails", including extinct volcanoes the city stands on, Sky Tower - the highest in Southern Hemisphere, beautiful bohemian Parnell, imposing Auckland Domain with its Museum, white sandy beaches and beautiful marinas, fish market, Harbour Bridge and CBD. Auckland is the biggest metropolis of New Zealand, a place where many Polynesian and world cultures meet and coexist complementing each other. The city is located between two big ocean harbours and that fact adds to the general charm of the place by bringing lots of beautiful vistas and colours into the picture. The city is also famous for its fine dining, art galleries, South Pacific fashion and designs, wonderful parks, and last but not least - very friendly and helpful inhabitants that will do their best to make your holiday a memorable event.

Kindly note: The tour can also start in Auckland International Airport and after the tour you can be delivered to your hotel or to your cruise ship. There is a little surcharge for the airport pick up.

Auckland – Rotorua Geothermal Wonders - Auckland

This tour will take you to the heart of North Island where nature's forces are in full display. You will see geysers erupting in white plumes, national icon - flightless kiwi bird, boiling mud pools and sulfur terraces of unbelievable colors. You will get your first introduction into ancient Maori culture, philosophy, arts and crafts. For lunch we will go up the hill in a gondola, to soak in the panorama of the valley and enjoy sumptuous local food buffet of meats, fish, sea foods, vegetables and cheeses, followed by excellent desserts. After lunch our choices are plenty: to see a fun show with sheep, cows and sheep shearers or, perhaps, visit a local Zoo with endemic New Zealand bird and fish species, or relax in world famous Polynesian SPA pools - where you will find natural mineral hot pools of various temperatures healing and soothing at the same time. You will return to Auckland in the late evening full of unforgettable experiences of the day.

Auckland – Bay of Islands - Auckland

Through the newly built tunnel in the hills surrounding Auckland we will take Highway 1 northbound heading towards the famous Bay of Islands – the Birthplace of New Zealand. It was here in 1840 that the Maori chiefs signed the Treaty of Waitangi with the British Crown, thus creating “one nation from two people”. On the way you will see beautiful ocean vistas, rolling green pastures, gigantic fern trees and thick lush jungle, called bush in New Zealand.

We will stop in the Honey Centre for tastings of fragrant local honey with medicinal properties.

Upon arrival to Paihia, quaint elegant town on the ocean you will visit the Waitangi Grounds with the ceremonial Waka – biggest war canoe in New Zealand. You will learn about the distant and recent history of this exotic land, and about its future hopes and aspirations.

After splendid lunch of fresh local produce you will board an ocean catamaran for a trip to iconic Hole in the Rock in the Pacific Ocean, dolphins encounter and sightings of wild uninhabited islands that remind of Robinson Crusoe times.

We will return to Auckland in the late afternoon.
